National Conference – 2016

It will mirror Oregon's fall conference (Wednesday night reception, full day Thursday and a ½ day Friday). Different tracks would be offered to attract executive level individuals. A SAVE THE DATE should go out with an invitation to presidents.

Cherie recommended the planning committee be an ecommittee. Dawn mentioned Carmen, Dawn, Alasha, Beverly and someone from the east coast and Lynn and Cherie. Ecommittee to brainstorm theme. Call for Proposals will go out as soon as theme is determined.

<u>Speakers</u> - National will provide. Mary Spilde will be one; two others are needed. <u>Marketing</u> will be done at the 2015 Fall Conference and the 2016 AACC conference.

<u>Breakout Sessions</u> - Cherie planned for 10 breakout sessions; Dawn tentatively planning on 25. Three tracks discussed (executive, leader, life in balance).

Normal awards may not happen during national conference.

<u>Silent Auction</u> – May do and have Oregon keep all profits rather than splitting with national.

Entertainment – Dawn suggested Linda Reisser's group for the opening (The Bondettes).
